

Level 2 Umpiring Courses

Course Details

The course will cost £25 per attendee

What is involved in passing the course?

On the night of the course

- 1) Pass a written Rules Question test paper, Candidates must attain a 75% pass mark.
- 2) Attend a Presentation to help improve your Umpiring Skills and Knowledge.
- 3) Take an active part in a Question and Answer session regarding present Interpretation of the rules.

At a later date

- 4) Umpire a game that is deemed by us to be at a level that a level 2 umpire can control. This game will be watched by an appointed Umpire assessor who will determine if you are of a good enough standard to be a level 2 umpire

(We will be using North Wales Men's cup games to watch and assess your umpiring skills. These games are taking place on a Sunday in early January 2012 and you will need to be available to attend and umpire an appointed match).

Who can attend the course and Pre-Requisites for attending the course?

- 1) You **MUST** presently be a registered umpire with Welsh Hockey Umpires Association.
- 2) Ideally you will have been a level 1 umpire for about 2 years and have been regularly umpiring during this 2 year period.

Exceptions to this are that you can be recommended by another presently qualified level 2 or above umpire as already umpiring at a standard that could see you pass the level 2 Umpires course.

Note: You may feel yourself that you are able to umpire to level 2 standard, if so we are willing to come along and carryout a pre course watching assessment to see if you are of a level to attend the course.

3) You should already be umpiring games of a level 2 umpiring standard (as a general guide this would be Men's North West England Leagues division 5 and above, Women's North Wales Division 1)

After the watching session you will be given a written assessment of how you umpired and this will include recommendations if you have passed and also suggestions of how you can improve your umpiring even if you have passed, or not.
